

Hell - Eternal Place for the Wicked:

After these thousand years of torment, they will be resurrected to a telestial glory.

Latter-day revelations speak of hell in at least two ways.

<u>First</u>, it is another name for spirit prison, a temporary place in the postmortal world for those who died without knowledge of the truth or those who were disobedient in mortality.

In this sense, hell has an end.

The spirits there will be taught the gospel, and sometime following their repentance they will be resurrected to a degree of glory of which they are worthy.

Those who will not repent, but are nevertheless not sons of perdition, will remain in hell throughout the Millennium.

After these thousand years of torment, they will be resurrected to a telestial glory.

The telestial glory; being like a star as one star differs in glory from another star.

Second, it is the permanent location of those who are not redeemed by the atonement of Jesus Christ.

In this sense, hell is permanent.

It is for those who are found "filthy still".

This is the place where Satan, his angels, and the sons of perdition—those who have denied the Son after the Father has revealed him—will dwell eternally

Hell is the permanent location of Satan and his followers and the sons of perdition, who are not redeemed by the Atonement of Jesus Christ.

The scriptures sometimes refer to hell as outer darkness.

Spirit prison is a temporary state in which spirits will be taught the gospel and have the opportunity to repent and accept ordinances of salvation that are performed for them in temples.

Those who accept the gospel may dwell in paradise until the Resurrection.

After they are resurrected and judged, they will receive the degree of glory of which they are worthy.

Those who choose not to repent but who are not sons of perdition will remain in spirit prison until the end of the Millennium, when they will be freed from hell and punishment and be resurrected to a telestial glory.

Those who are not redeemed by the Atonement are in outer darkness, which is the dwelling place of the devil, his angels, and the sons of perdition.

Sons of perdition are those who receive "no forgiveness in this world nor in the world to come—having denied the Holy Spirit after having received it, and having denied the Only Begotten Son of the Father, having crucified him unto themselves and put him to an open shame".

Such individuals will not inherit a place in any kingdom of glory; for them the conditions of hell remain.

David's soul shall not be left in hell.

Psalm 86:13	For great is thy mercy toward me: and <u>thou hast delivered my soul from the</u> <u>lowest hell</u> . (There are levels in Hell.)
Psalm 16:10	For thou <u>wilt not leave my soul in hell</u> ; <u>neither wilt thou suffer</u> thine Holy One to see corruption. (The repentant person will not be left in Hell.)

Go into hell, into that fire that never shall be quenched.

Mark 9:43	And if thy hand offend thee, cut it off: it is better for thee to enter into life maimed, than having two hands to <u>go into hell, into the fire that never shall be</u> <u>quenched</u> : (Hell is a very sorry place to go.)
Mark 9:44	Where their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched. (You will be tormented forever.)
The rich man in he	ell lifts up his eyes, being in torment.
Luke 16:20	And there was a certain beggar named Lazarus, which was laid at his gate, full of sores,
Luke 16:21	And <u>desiring to be fed with the crumbs which fell from the rich man's table</u> : moreover the dogs came and licked his sores. (We need to do good to all.)
Luke 16:22	And it came to pass, that the <u>beggar died</u> , and was <u>carried by the angels</u> into Abraham's bosom: <u>the rich man also died</u> , and <u>was buried</u> ; (They both died and went to different places. Spirit Prison and Paradise.)
Luke 16:23	And <u>in hell he lift up his eyes, being in torments</u> , and <u>seeth Abraham afar off</u> , <u>and Lazarus in his bosom</u> . (Hell is full of torments.)
Luke 16:24	And <u>he cried</u> and said, Father Abraham, <u>have mercy on me</u> , and send Lazarus, that he may dip the tip of his finger in water, and <u>cool my tongue; for I am</u> <u>tormented in this flame</u> . (The torments are great forever.)
Luke 16:25	But Abraham said, Son, <u>remember that thou in thy lifetime receivedst thy</u> <u>good things</u> , and <u>likewise Lazarus evil things</u> : but <u>now he is comforted</u> , and <u>thou art tormented</u> . (In Paradise he is comforted and the other is tormented.)
Luke 16:26	And beside all this, <u>between us and you there is a great gulf fixed</u> : so that <u>they</u> <u>which would pass from hence to you cannot</u> ; <u>neither can they pass to us</u> , that <u>would come from thence</u> . (There is a great Gulf between Paradise and Spirit Prison.)
Luke 16:27	Then he said, I pray thee therefore, father, <u>that thou wouldest send him to my</u> <u>father's house</u> : (Spirit Prison person wanted to send some from the dead to go to his family and convert them from their wrong ways and teaching.)
Luke 16:28	For I have five brethren; that <u>he may testify unto them, lest they also come into</u> <u>this place of torment</u> . (The Dead would testify unto them of the true way of the Lord, but Jesus Christ said no, if they would not follow the scriptures and the prophets, that sending someone from the dead would not work.)

Luke 16:29	Abraham saith unto him, <u>They have Moses and the prophets; let them hear</u> <u>them</u> . (The scriptures and the Prophets teach us the true way and not the concepts of men. The Lord Jesus Christ would restore His Church and Prophets.)
Luke 16:30	And he said, <u>Nay</u> , father Abraham: <u>but if one went unto them from the dead</u> , <u>they will repent</u> . (The man begged the Lord so his family would not end up in the same place as he did in Hell.)
Luke 16:31	And he said unto him, <u>If they hear not Moses and the prophets, neither will</u> they be persuaded, though one rose from the dead. (If they truly repent and listen to the Scriptures and the Prophets, the Lord said they would not be willing to change their ways.)

Death and Hell delivered up the dead.

Revelation 20:12	And <u>I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God</u> ; and <u>the books were</u> <u>opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life</u> : and <u>the</u> <u>dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books,</u> <u>according to their works</u> . (We will be judge out of many books of our works.)
Revelation 20:13	And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and <u>death and hell delivered up</u> <u>the dead which were in them</u> : and <u>they were judged every man according to</u> <u>their works</u> . (We are judge of our WORKS.)
Revelation 20:14	And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death. (After our earthly death, the wrong doers will be casted into a lake of fire and it is a second death, they are not in Paradise where the righteous goes.)
Revelation 20:15	And <u>whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the</u> <u>lake of fire</u> . (The righteous, those who repented of the sins and forsake them are in the book of life, but those who do not repent and forsake will go to the lake of fire.)

There is a place prepared, yea, even that awful hell.

The will of the flesh giveth the spirit of the devil power to bring us down to hell.

Jesus Christ prepared the way for our deliverance from death and hell.

Those who remain filthy go into everlasting torment.

The devil cheateth their souls and leadeth them away carefully down to hell.

Jesus Christ hath redeemed our soul from hell, if we repent of our sins.

Loose yourselves from the pains of hell.

To be taken captive by the devil and led by his will to destruction are the chains of hell.

The wicked are cast into outer darkness or spirit prison until the time of their resurrection.

The filthy would be more miserable to dwell with Heavenly Father, and Jesus Christ than to dwell in hell.

The punishment which is given from my hand is endless punishment.

Hell is a place prepared for the devil and his angels.

Those who acknowledge Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost are delivered from death and the chains of hell.

Sons of Perdition:

The followers of Satan who will suffer with him in eternity.

Sons of perdition include those who followed Satan and were cast out of heaven for rebellion during premortality, and those who were permitted to be born to this world with physical bodies but then served Satan and turned utterly against God.

Those in this second group will be resurrected from the dead but will not be redeemed from the second (spiritual) death and cannot dwell in a kingdom of glory

None of them is lost but the son of perdition.

John 17:12 While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost, <u>but the son of perdition; that</u> the scripture might be fulfilled. (All the scriptures tells us that the wrong doers, are lost and become the sons of perdition.)

It is impossible to renew them again unto repentance.

Hebrews 6:8	But that which beareth thorns and briers is rejected, and is nigh unto cursing; whose end is to be burned. (Those who do not bring forth good fruits but bring for thorns and briers will be burned.)
Hebrews 10:26	For <u>if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth,</u> <u>there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins</u> , (After knowing the 10 commandments and the scriptures, and then wilfully sin and does not repent and forsake, that the Lord's sacrifice will not work for his sins.)
Hebrews 10:27	But a certain fearful looking for of judgment <u>and fiery indignation, which shall</u> <u>devour the adversaries</u> . (Hell is not a good place to go forever, we need to repent and keep the commandments.)
Hebrews 10:28	He that despised Moses' law died without mercy under two or three witnesses: (We need to read and learn from the scriptures to help prevent us from going to Hell.)
Hebrews 10:29	Of <u>how much sorer punishment</u> , suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the Son of God, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, <u>an unholy thing</u> , and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace? (Do not give up the Lord's sacrifice for our sins be wasted.)

Mercy hath no claim on that man and his final doom is never-ending torment.

He is as though there was no redemption made.

Those who deny Jesus Christ's miracles to get gain shall become like the son of perdition.

They will receive no forgiveness in this world or the next.

They are the only ones who will not be redeemed from the second death.

Sons of perdition deny the Holy Spirit after receiving it.

Sons of perdition deny the Son after the Father has revealed him.

Cain shall be called Perdition.

Devil:

Satan.

The devil is the enemy of righteousness and of those who seek to do the will of Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost.

Satan is literally a spirit son of God and was at one time an angel in authority in the presence of Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost.

However, Satan rebelled in the premortal life and Satan persuaded a third part of the spirit children of Heavenly Father to rebel with him.

Satan and one third of the spirit children of Heavenly Father were cast out of heaven, were denied the opportunity of obtaining mortal bodies and experiencing mortal life, and will be eternally damned.

Since the time the devil was cast out of heaven, he has sought constantly to deceive all men and women and lead them away from the work of Heavenly Father, Jesus Christ, and the Holy Ghost in order to make all mankind as miserable as he is.

Revelation 12:7	And <u>there was war in heaven</u> : <u>Michael and his angels fought against the</u> <u>dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels</u> , (In the beginning there was a war in heaven and the dragon or Satan and 1/3 of the hosts in heaven, fought against Michael and his angels.)
Revelation 12:8	And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven . (Satan and his 1/3 of his followers had no place in heaven.)
Revelation 12:9	And <u>the great dragon was cast out</u> , that old serpent, called the Devil, and <u>Satan</u> , which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and <u>his angels were cast out with him</u> . (Satan and his 1/3 hosts were cast out of heaven, and they deceiveth everyone on the earth to do sin.)

Jesus rebuked the devil.

Matthew 17:18 And <u>Jesus rebuked the devil</u>; and <u>he departed out of him</u>: and the child was cured from that very hour. (The devil or Satan is real, for he was real to Jesus Christ and tried to deceive Him.)

Everlasting fire is prepared for the devil and his angels

Matthew 25:41Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, Depart from me, ye
cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels: (Those
that do sin and do not repent and forsake sin, are cursed to everlasting fire.)

Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

James 4:4	Ye adulterers and adulteresses, <u>know ye not that the friendship of the world is</u> <u>enmity with God</u> ? <u>whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the</u> <u>enemy of God</u> . (The ways of the world is not the ways of the Lord.)
James 4:5	Do ye think that the scripture saith in vain , The spirit that dwelleth in us lusteth to envy? (The scriptures teaches us not to sin. We need to read.)
James 4:6	But he giveth more grace. Wherefore he saith, <u>God resisteth the proud</u> , but giveth grace unto the humble. (Watch out for pride.)
James 4:7	Submit yourselves therefore to God. <u>Resist the devil, and he will flee from you</u> . (As we study the scriptures and live the commandments and be kind to others, Satan will flee from us.)

The wicked will be brought down into the captivity of the devil.

The devil is the father of all lies.

The devil seeks that all men might be miserable like unto himself.

If the flesh should rise no more, our spirits must become subject to the devil.

The devil will rage, pacify, and flatter.

That which is evil comes from the devil.

Beware lest contentions arise among you, and ye obey the evil spirit.

If ye are not the sheep of the good shepherd, the devil is your shepherd.

The devil will not support his children.

Pray continually that ye may not be led away by the temptations of the devil.

Build your foundation upon the Redeemer that the devil's mighty storm shall have no power over you.

The devil is the author of all sin.

The devil sought to lay a cunning plan.

It must needs be that the devil tempt the children of men, or they could not be agents.

Adam became subject to the will of the devil because he yielded unto temptation.

The sons of perdition will reign with the devil and his angels in eternity.

The devil will be bound for a thousand years.

Revelation 20:1 And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. (An angel has the KEY of Hell.)
Revelation 20:2 And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, (An angel will bound Satan in Hell.)
Revelation 20:3 And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season. (Satan and 1/3 will have a seal upon them so that they will not deceive the world no more.)

The wicked one takes away light and truth.

Satan kept not his first estate.

The church of the devil:

Every evil and worldly organization on earth that perverts the pure and perfect gospel and fights against the Lamb of God.

The devil founded the great and abominable church.

There are only two churches, one of the Lamb of God and one of the devil:.

Contend against no church, save it be the church of the devil.

The great and abominable church shall be cast down.

Who Is The Antichrist:

The son of perdition opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God.

He deceives them that dwell on the earth by the means of miracles.

Antichrists are false leaders and churches which teaches some of the truths of Jesus Christ, Apostles, and the scriptures, but not of all the saving ordinances of the gospel.

An Antichrist uses bits and pieces of the gospel of Jesus Christ and misleads others and even themselves, for they will go to spirit prison.

Revelation 13:13	And he doeth great wonders, so that <u>he maketh fire come down from heaven</u> <u>on the earth in the sight of men</u> , (Satan will prepare a man to be the beast and cause fire to come down in the sight of man.)
Revelation 13:14	And <u>deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by the means of those miracles</u> <u>which he had power to do in the sight of the beast</u> ; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live. (Satan will deceive many on the earth. Satan will do miracles.)
Revelation 13:15	And <u>he had power to give life unto the image of the beast, that the image of the beast should both speak, and cause that as many as would not worship the image of the beast should be killed.</u> (Satan will cause many to worship the man and if you did not, you would be put to death.)
Revelation 13:16	And he <u>causeth all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to</u> <u>receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads</u> : (A mark is needed for all people of the earth in Satan new one world order.)
Revelation 13:17	And <u>that no man might buy or sell</u> , save he that had the mark, or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. (Without the mark, no one could buy or sell, Satan's one world order or government.)

Many churches taught false doctrines, established a church, and introduced priestcraft.

Many false church leaders ridiculed Jesus Christ, the Atonement, and the spirit of prophecy.

Destroyer:

Satan is the destroyer.

The Lord will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses.

Exodus 12:23 For the LORD will pass through to smite the Egyptians; and when he seeth the blood upon the lintel, and on the two side posts, the LORD will pass over the door, and <u>will not suffer the destroyer to come in unto your houses to smite</u> you. (Satan is the destroyer of life of the wicked.)

The destroyer rides upon the waters.

The watchman could have saved my vineyard from the destroyer.

Lucifer:

Anyone or anything that counterfeits the true gospel plan of salvation and that openly or secretly opposes Christ.

John the Revelator described the antichrist as a deceiver.

1 John 2:18	Little children, <u>it is the last time</u> : and <u>as ye have heard that antichrist shall</u> <u>come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time</u> . (In the last days, there will be many false churches and leaders of their own making, and they are a antichrists, for they do not believe in Jesus Christ's Restoration of His Church and Organization, (1 Corinthians 12:14-31) Melchizedek Priesthood, Aaronic Priesthood, Keys, Prophets, 12 Apostles, Seventies, Patriarchs, Bishops, High Priests, Elders, and Aaronic Priesthood; Deacons, Teachers, Priests, and Auxiliaries groups.)
1 John 2:19	<u>They went out from us, but they were not of us</u> ; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us. (The false churches formed their own in the form of Christ church, but denied the Restored Church in the last days.)
1 John 2:20	But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things.

1 John 2:21	<u>I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth</u> . (The scriptures inform us His Restore Church and Organization and how it performs with its ordinations.)
1 John 2:22	Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. (Our Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ are real and alive today, and we need to follow everything in the scriptures, not just bits and pieces of it, like false churches and leaders do.)
1 John 4:3	And <u>every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is</u> <u>not of God</u> : and <u>this is that spirit of antichrist</u> , whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world. (Jesus Christ has a body of flesh and bones, and is alive today, as yesterday, and we need to confess it to everyone in the world.)
1 John 4:4	Ye are of God, little children, and have overcome them: because greater is he that is in you, <u>than he that is in the world</u> . (There is God's ways and there is the world's ways.)
1 John 4:5	They are of the world: therefore speak they of the world, and the world heareth them. (Many churches are of the world and not of the Lord way.)
1 John 4:6	We are of God: he that knoweth God heareth us; <u>he that is not of God heareth</u> <u>not us</u> . Hereby know we the spirit of truth, and <u>the spirit of error</u> . (Jesus Christ will hear His true people of His restored Church in the last days, which many will reject Him again, that is why many are chosen, but few will follow His restored way.)
1 John 4:7	Beloved, let us love one another: for love is of God; and every one that loveth is born of God, and knoweth God. (If we truly love God, we would love others the way God wants us too.)
1 John 4:8	<u>He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love</u> . (If you love God, you would keep all of His commandments.)
2 John 1:6	And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it. (We need to keep His commandments, not just bits and pieces of the commandments.)
2 John 1:7	For <u>many deceivers are entered into the world</u> , <u>who confess not that Jesus</u> <u>Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist</u> . (Many false leaders and churches are deceivers and an antichrist, because they are teaching others of incomplete doctrine of the gospel of Jesus Christ.)
2 John 1:8	Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we <u>receive a full reward</u> . (To receive a full reward from Jesus Christ we need to keep and teach the whole gospel of Jesus Christ.)

2 John 1:9	Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son. (When we sin we cannot be of Jesus Christ and Heavenly Father.)
2 John 1:10	If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed: (We need the full doctrine of Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ, within the last days, there will be many false churches and leaders of their own making, and they are an antichrists, for they do not believe in Jesus Christ's Restoration of His Church and Organization, Melchizedek Priesthood, Aaronic Priesthood, Keys, Prophets, 12 Apostles, Seventies, Patriarchs, Bishops, High Priests, Elders, and Aaronic Priesthood; Deacons, Teachers, Priests, and Auxiliaries groups.)
2 John 1:11	For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds. (When we

The great antichrist is Lucifer, but he has many assistants, both spirit beings and mortals.

follow these false leaders and false churches, we are partakers of evil deeds.)

The name means the Shining One or Light bearer.

He is also known as the Son of the Morning.

Lucifer was a spirit son of Heavenly Father and led the rebellion in the premortal life.

The name Lucifer appears only once in the Bible.

Isaiah 14:12	How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations! (Satan/Devil/Lucifer is the son of the morning and his followers, was cast out of Heaven, and with his deceiving the whole world.)
Isaiah 14:13	For thou hast said in thine heart, <u>I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my</u> <u>throne above the stars of God</u> : I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: (Lucifer or Satan wanted to be higher than our Heavenly Father and glory be to Lucifer.)
Isaiah 14:14	I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; <u>I will be like the most High</u> . (Lucifer wanted to be all glory to him and not to our Heavenly Father.)
Isaiah 14:15	Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit. (For Satan desires was wrong and he got one third of our brothers and sisters to follow him, they will be cast down to hell and not receive a body like us.)

Latter-day revelation gives more detail on Lucifer's fall.

Lucifer fell in the premortal existence.

- Luke 10:16He that heareth you heareth me; and he that despiseth you despiseth me; and
he that despiseth me despiseth him that sent me. (When we follow Jesus
Christ, we are His heirs, but when someone despise us that follow Jesus
Christ, despiseth Jesus Christ and Heavenly Father, too.)
- Luke 10:17And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are
subject unto us through thy name. (Through the priesthood they had, even
the devils are subject unto them.)

After his fall he became Satan and the Devil.

Accountability:



The Lord has said that all people are responsible for their own motives, attitudes, desires, and actions.

The age of accountability is the age at which children are considered to be responsible for their actions and capable of committing sin and repenting.

I will judge every one according to his ways.

Ezekiel 18:30Therefore I will judge you, O house of Israel, every one according to his ways,
saith the Lord GOD. Repent, and turn yourselves from all your
transgressions; so iniquity shall not be your ruin. (The Lord wants us to stop
what we are doing wrong and hurting others, and repent while there is time
to do so, before the Lord will say no more.)

They shall give account of every idle word.

- Matthew 12:34 O generation of vipers, how can ye, <u>being evil, speak good things</u>? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. (As we are doing evil, we must stop and repent and be baptized and receive the Holy Ghost by those having the restored Priesthood for all other baptism are false without the restored Priesthood.)
- Matthew 12:35 A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an <u>evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things</u>. (Evil is of the Devil and can only bring forth evil.)
- Matthew 12:36 But I say unto you, <u>That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give</u> <u>account thereof in the day of judgment</u>. (We need to make sure we say good things and not just idle things, for we will be judge for our idleness.)
- Matthew 12:37 For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned. (We will be condemned for the false words or idle words or words against other people.)

Give an account of thy stewardship.

Luke 16:2 And he called him, and said unto him, How is it that I hear this of thee? <u>give an</u> <u>account of thy stewardship</u>; for thou mayest be no longer steward. (We will have to give an account of our stewardship when we die. We all have a mission here on the earth to follow, but many fall short of our mission and idle, play, and etc. it away.)

Every one of us shall give an account of himself to God.

Romans 14:11 For it is written, As I live, saith the Lord, <u>every knee shall bow to me, and</u> <u>every tongue shall confess to God</u>. (We all will have to meet Jesus Christ and bow before Him and give an account to Him.)

Romans 14:12 So then every one of us shall give account of himself to God. (We all will give an account of our stewardship of our mission and life here on earth.)

The dead will be judged according to their works.

- Revelation 20:12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and <u>the dead</u> were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. (We will be judge of our works here on earth.)
- Revelation 20:13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and <u>they were judged every man according to</u> <u>their works</u>. (To Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ, our works tells the story of our life here on earth, and we are accountable for our mission.)
- Revelation 20:14 And <u>death and hell were cast into the lake of fire</u>. This is the <u>second death</u>. (The wicked will go to the lake of fire, with is a second death and will spend the eternities there.)

Our words, works, and thoughts will condemn us.

We are our own judges, whether to do good or evil.

Ye are permitted to act for yourselves.

This thing shall ye teach—repentance and baptism unto those who are accountable.

All must repent and be baptized who have arrived at the years of accountability.

Satan cannot tempt little children, until they begin to become accountable before me.

Children shall be baptized when eight years old.

Every man will be accountable for his own sins in the day of judgment.

It is given unto men to know good from evil; wherefore they are agents unto themselves.

Men will be punished for their own sins and their works.

Captivity:

To be in physical or spiritual bondage.

The house of Israel went into captivity for their iniquity,

He that leads into captivity shall go into captivity.

The wicked will be brought down into the captivity of the devil.

Men are free to choose liberty and eternal life or captivity and death.

The will of the flesh gives the spirit of the devil power to captivate.

Have you sufficiently retained in remembrance the captivity of your fathers?

They who harden their hearts are taken captive by the devil.

Watch and pray always, lest ye be tempted by the devil, and ye be led away captive by him.

Sin:

Sin comes in many forms like; Abominable, Abomination; Filth, Filthiness; Offend; Rebellion; Ungodly; Unrighteous, Unrighteousness; Wicked, Wickedness, Apostasy, Murmur, etc.

Willful disobedience to God's commandments.

He that covereth his sins shall not prosper.

Though your sins be as scarlet, they shall be as white as snow when you repent and forsake.

Sinners shall die, and the righteous shall be saved.

The Lamb of God taketh away the sins of the world.

Be baptized, and wash away thy sins.

The wages of sin is death.

To him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin.

Wilt thou make me that I may shake at the appearance of sin.

Wo unto all those who die in their sins.

They could not look upon sin save it were with abhorrence.

Do not suppose ye will be restored from sin to happiness.

The Lord cannot look upon sin with the least degree of allowance.

Little children are not capable of committing sin.

To repent, men must confess and forsake their sins.

The greater sin remains in him who forgives not.

He who sins against the greater light shall receive the greater condemnation.

Unto that soul who sinneth shall the former sins return.

When we undertake to cover our sins, the heavens withdraw themselves.

Rebellion:

Defying or opposing the Lord Jesus Christ, Heavenly Father, and the Holy Ghost, including refusing to follow his chosen leaders and willfully disobeying his commandments.

Rebel not ye against the Lord.

An evil man seeketh only rebellion.

Woe to the rebellious children.

The Lord redeemeth none such that rebel against him and die in their sins.

Many came out in open rebellion against God.

The rebellious shall be pierced with much sorrow.

The Lord's anger is kindled against the rebellious.

Satan rebelled against God.

Apostasy:

A turning away from the truth by individuals, the Church, or entire nations.

General apostasy:

Israel had to guard against their hearts turning away from the Lord.

Deuteronomy 29:18	Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, whose heart
	turneth away this day from the LORD our God, to go and serve the gods of
	these nations; lest there should be among you a root that beareth gall and
	wormwood; (There are many false leaders and churches that are causing
	many to serve false gods of the world.)

Deuteronomy 29:19 And <u>it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse</u>, that <u>he bless</u> <u>himself in his heart, saying</u>, I shall have peace, <u>though I walk in the</u> <u>imagination of mine heart</u>, to add drunkenness to thirst: (These false leaders and churches are cursed, for they teach only bits and pieces and do not have the true authority act for the Lord and priesthood of Jesus Christ.)

Deuteronomy 29:20 The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven. (The false leaders and churches will be blotted out of Heaven and all the curses of the scriptures will be upon them and all those that follow them.)

Deuteronomy 29:21 And <u>the LORD shall separate him unto evil</u> out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law: (All the curses of the scriptures will be upon them.)

Where there is no vision, the people perish.

Proverbs 29:18 <u>Where there is no vision, the people perish</u>: but he that keepeth the law, happy is he. (We need visions, revelations, scriptures, even in these last days, if not all would perish.)

They have broken the everlasting covenant.

Isaiah 24:5 The <u>earth also is defiled under the inhabitants</u> thereof; <u>because they have</u> <u>transgressed the laws, changed the ordinance, broken the everlasting</u> <u>covenant</u>. (Many false leaders and churches have changed the ordinances and have broken the everlasting covenant of the Lord in these last days. We need the full Ordinances, Covenants, Doctrine of Heavenly Father and Jesus Christ, within the Last Days, there will be many false churches and leaders of their own making, and they are an antichrists, for they do not believe in Jesus Christ's Restoration of His Church and Organization, Melchizedek Priesthood, Aaronic Priesthood, Keys, Prophets, 12 Apostles, Seventies, Patriarchs, Bishops, High Priests, Elders, and Aaronic Priesthood; Deacons, Teachers, Priests, and Auxiliaries groups.)

The winds beat upon that house, and it fell.

- Matthew 7:26 And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and <u>doeth them not, shall be</u> <u>likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand</u>: (Many will be washed away when the storm comes, not having the restored gospel of Jesus Christ in the Last Days.)
- Matthew 7:27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and <u>it fell: and great was the fall of it</u>. (Many will fall who are not of the restored house of Jesus Christ in the Latter Days.)

They commenced in the good path but lost their way in the mist:.

After they had tasted of the fruit, they fell away into forbidden paths.

Apostasy caused a stumbling block for nonbelievers.

Many members of the Church became proud and persecuted other members.

When the Lord prospers his people, they sometimes harden their hearts and forget him.

When individuals, groups, or nations, hardened their hearts and fall under Satan's power.

Many prophesied about apostasy in the last days.

Apostasy will precede the Second Coming.

Apostasy of the Early Christian Church:

This people draw near me with their mouth.

Darkness shall cover the earth.

The Lord will send a famine of hearing the words of the Lord.

There shall arise false Christ's and false prophets.

Grievous wolves shall enter in among you.

I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him.

There will be a falling away before the Second Coming.

Some people err concerning the truth.

Some people have a form of godliness but deny the power thereof.

The time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine.

2 Timothy 4:2 <u>Preach the word</u>; be instant in season, out of season; <u>reprove, rebuke, exhort</u> <u>with all longsuffering and doctrine</u>. (We need to preach the restored word or scriptures in the Latter Days. We need to reprove, rebuke, exhort, and with longsuffering and the restored doctrine of Jesus Christ.)

2 Timothy 4:3	For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears; (The bible is all the world needs and only bits and pieces of the bible is enough for them to believe in God. But the false leaders and churches will not endure the fullness on the gospel of Jesus Christ in the Latter Days.)
2 Timothy 4:4	And <u>they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto</u> <u>fables</u> . (When Jesus Christ will restore His Church in the Latter Days, many will turn away their ears from the truth, they will say the bible is all they need.)
2 Timothy 4:5	But watch thou in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, <u>make full proof of thy ministry</u> . (The restored fullness of the gospel will endure afflictions, like Jesus Christ did 2,000 years ago.)

There will be false prophets and false teachers among the people.

Certain men crept in denying the only Lord God.

Some men said they were Apostles and were not.

Prophets saw the formation of a great and abominable church.

The Gentiles have stumbled and built up many churches.

They have strayed from mine ordinances and have broken mine everlasting covenant.

Darkness covers the earth and gross darkness the minds of the people.

Prophets were told that the churches were all wrong; their hearts were far from God.

Restoration of the Gospel:

God's reestablishment of the truths and ordinances of his gospel among men on earth.

The gospel of Jesus Christ was lost from the earth through the apostasy that took place following the earthly ministry of Christ's Apostles.

That apostasy made necessary the restoration of the gospel.

Through visions, the ministering of angels, and revelations to men on the earth, God restored the gospel.

The Restoration started with the Prophet and has continued to the present through the work of the Lord's living prophets.

The Lord Jesus Christ will restore His House or Temple in the Last Days, our day, today.

He will have all the Ordinances, Covenants, Authority, and Priesthoods that He had before, for the Lord will not modify His Church to please us.

The Lord's house shall be established in the top of the mountains.

Isaiah 2:2 And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the mountain of the LORD's house shall be established in the top of the mountains, and shall be exalted above the hills; and all nations shall flow unto it. (We are in the Last Days, today, in the USA, are three mountains ranges, the Sierra Mountains in the west, Appalachian Mountains in the east, but the Rocky Mountains are from Canada to Mexico, the top of the mountains and the largest is where the Lord Jesus Christ will restore His Church in the Last Days and have a Temple or Lords House there in the land of the Gentiles of many people, not the Jews.) Isaiah 2:3 And many people shall go and say, Come ye, and let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob; and he will teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for out of Zion shall go forth the law, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. (The House or Temple of the Lord will be in the top of the mountain to the God of Jacob, for Jacob will be in the land of the Gentiles in the Last Days which allows freedom of religion. USA is the land of many different people or nationalities. A new book or new scriptures or law, and the word or bible from Jerusalem.) Isaiah 2:7 Their land also is full of silver and gold, neither is there any end of their treasures; their land is also full of horses, neither is there any end of their chariots: (In the USA in 1849, America discovered gold and silver and people from around the world came here to get it, but we cannot go to other countries and take out the gold and silver. We have more treasures like cell phones, TV's, microwaves, and a thousand other treasures in our life. Our land has more horses than any other nation as pets. We have more vehicles or chariots than any other nation. The Lord Jesus Christ is talking about the USA in the Last Days for restoring His Church.)

Micah 4:1	But in the last days it shall come to pass, that the mountain of the house of the LORD shall be established in the top of the mountains, and it shall be exalted above the hills; and people shall flow unto it. (The Lord repeats when and where He will restore His Church in the Last Days, again to the Gentiles in the land of many people.)
Micah 4:2	And <u>many nations shall come, and say, Come, and let us go up to the</u> <u>mountain of the LORD, and to the house of the God of Jacob</u> ; and <u>he will</u> <u>teach us of his ways, and we will walk in his paths: for the law shall go forth</u> <u>of Zion, and the word of the LORD from Jerusalem</u> . (The Lord Jesus Christ repeats this prophecy twice, because it is important through two different prophets.)
Micah 4:5	<u>For all people will walk every one in the name of his god</u> , and we will walk in the name of the LORD our God for ever and ever. (Because in the Last Days, there will be many false leaders and churches.)
Micah 5:8	And the remnant of Jacob shall be among the Gentiles in the midst of many people as a lion among the beasts of the forest, as a young lion among the flocks of sheep: who, if he go through, both treadeth down, and teareth in pieces, and none can deliver. (And Jacob will be among the Gentiles in the Last Days when Jesus Christ will restore His true Church on the earth again. The statue of liberty is a symbol of many people in the Last Days, the USA.)
God will do a r	narvelous work and a wonder.
Isaiah 29:10	For the LORD hath <u>poured out upon you the spirit of deep sleep</u> , and <u>hath</u> <u>closed your eyes</u> : the prophets and your rulers, the seers hath he covered. (A <u>deep sleep or Apostasy of the whole world even with the Bible, which means</u> there will be a restoration in the Last Days.)
Isaiah 29:11	And <u>the vision of all is become unto you as the words of a book that is sealed</u> , <u>which men deliver to one that is learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and</u> <u>he saith, I cannot; for it is sealed</u> : (A new book which is sealed in the ground to come forth in the Last Days and a learned person could not read it.)
Isaiah 29:12	And the book is delivered to him that is not learned, saying, Read this, I pray thee: and he saith, I am not learned. (The Lord would bring the sealed book to one that is not learned, for he is not set in his ways and can be taught the ways of the Lord, for a learned man has many false ideas.)
Isaiah 29:13	Wherefore the Lord said, <u>Forasmuch as this people draw near me with their</u> <u>mouth, and with their lips do honour me, but have removed their heart far</u> <u>from me, and their fear toward me is taught by the precept of men</u> : (Many <u>false leaders and churches draw near with mouth and lips, but there heart if</u> <u>far from Him and they are taught by false precepts of men.</u>)

Isaiah 29:14 Therefore, <u>behold, I will proceed to do a marvellous work among this people,</u> <u>even a marvellous work and a wonder: for the wisdom of their wise men</u> <u>shall perish, and the understanding of their prudent men shall be hid</u>. (Great marvelous work and a wonder will be restored again on the earth, the Lords Kingdom restored, but wise and prudent will perish that say God can or will not restore His Church again in our day, the Latter Days.)

God shall set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed.

Daniel 2:44 And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven <u>set up a kingdom</u>, <u>which</u> <u>shall never be destroyed</u>: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and <u>consume all these kingdoms</u>, <u>and it shall stand for</u> <u>ever</u>. (Thy kingdom be done on earth as it is done in heaven, is here today in the Latter Days. His restore Church will never be destroyed again and not left to other people or other churches. The Lord Jesus Christ's Church in the latter days will stand into the Millennium.)

Elias will come, and restore all things.

- Matthew 17:11 And Jesus answered and said unto them, <u>Elias truly shall first come, and</u> <u>restore all things</u>. (The restored Church of Jesus Christ in the Latter Days is the Elias before the Millennium; the fore runner.)
- Mark 9:12 And he answered and told them, <u>Elias verily cometh first, and restoreth all</u> <u>things</u>; and how it is written of the Son of man, that he must suffer many things, and be set at nought. (The restored Church of the Lord Jesus Christ is here today in all the power and glory of the Lord.)

There will come times of restitution of all things.

Acts 3:21 Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began. (We are in the time of restitution of all things pertaining to the building up of the Lord's restored Church today.)

In the dispensation of the fulness of times, God will gather together in one all things.

Ephesians 1:10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him: (The Lord has restore His Kingdom again unto the earth and it has the priesthood powers of the Lord Jesus Christ today.)

I saw another angel, having the everlasting gospel to preach.

Revelation 14:6 And <u>I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting</u> <u>gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and</u> <u>kindred, and tongue, and people</u>, (The Bible is already here for thousand of years and all around the world. But another Gospel or Scriptures need to be brought forth in the Latter Days and go to all nations, kindred, and tongue, and people. The restored will have to be a large Church in the last days to go to all nations with another scripture and it will be 2 by 2 the missionaries to every nation.)

The fulness of the gospel will come unto the Gentiles.

The Jews shall be restored to the true church.

In the latter day shall the truth come.

Upon you I confer the Priesthood of Aaron.

I have committed the keys of the kingdom for the last times.

Gather together the tribes of Israel and restore all things.

The keys of this dispensation are committed.

The priesthood is given in the dispensation of the fulness of times.

I will reveal unto you the priesthood, by the hand of Elijah.

The Lord's Kingdom is restored on the earth today.

<u>The Lord Jesus Christ, wants the best for you in these latter days and it is this</u> <u>sealed book just for you which is not the Bible.</u> <u>The Bible and this other Book</u> <u>will be one in His hand in the Last Days.</u>

Matthew 5:19Whosoever therefore shall break one of
these least commandments, and shall
teach men so, he shall be called the least
in the kingdom of heaven: but whosoever
shall do and teach them, the same shall be
called great in the kingdom of heaven.

Three Kingdoms of Glory:

There are three kingdoms of glory: the celestial kingdom, the terrestrial kingdom, and the telestial kingdom. The glory we inherit will depend on the depth of our conversion, expressed by our obedience to the Lord's commandments. It will depend on the manner in which we have "received the testimony of Jesus".

(See Below)

<u>Celestial Kingdom – Like the Sun:</u>

The celestial kingdom is the highest of the three kingdoms of glory.

Those in this kingdom will dwell forever in the presence of God the Father and His Son Jesus Christ.

This should be our goal: to inherit celestial glory and to help others receive that great blessing as well.

Such a goal is not achieved in one attempt; it is the result of a lifetime of righteousness and constancy of purpose.

The celestial kingdom is the place prepared for those who have "received the testimony of Jesus" and been "made perfect through Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, who wrought out this perfect atonement through the shedding of his own blood".

To inherit this gift, we must receive the ordinances of salvation, keep the commandments, and repent of our sins.

"All who have died without a knowledge of this gospel, who would have received it if they had been permitted to tarry, shall be heirs of the celestial kingdom of God; "Also all that shall die henceforth without a knowledge of it, who would have received it with all their hearts, shall be heirs of that kingdom;

"For I, the Lord, will judge all men according to their works, according to the desire of their hearts".

"I also beheld that all children who die before they arrive at the years of accountability are saved in the celestial kingdom of heaven".

There are three degrees within the celestial kingdom.

To be exalted in the highest degree and continue eternally in family relationships, we must enter into "the new and everlasting covenant of marriage" and be true to that covenant.

In other words, temple marriage is a requirement for obtaining the highest degree of celestial glory.

All who are worthy to enter into the new and everlasting covenant of marriage will have that opportunity, whether in this life or the next.

Love Heavenly Father, Love the Lord Jesus Christ, and Love the Holy Ghost, Be Beloved, Be Holy, Bowels of Mercies, Do All Your Duties, Forbearing One Another, Forgiving, Helping the Poor, Humbleness of Mind, Keep The Commandments, Kindness, Longsuffering, Meekness, Repent and Forsake

<u>Terrestrial Kingdom – Like the Moon:</u>

Those who inherit terrestrial glory will "receive of the presence of the Son, but not of the fulness of the Father.

Wherefore, they are bodies terrestrial, and not bodies celestial, and differ in glory as the moon differs from the sun".

Generally speaking, individuals in the terrestrial kingdom will be honorable people "who were blinded by the craftiness of men".

This group will include members of the Church who were "not valiant in the testimony of Jesus".

It will also include those who rejected the opportunity to receive the gospel in mortality but who later received it in the postmortal spirit world.

Love Heavenly Father, Love the Lord Jesus Christ, and Love the Holy Ghost, Be Beloved, Be Holy, Bowels of Mercies, Do All Your Duties, Forbearing One Another, Forgiving, Helping the Poor, Humbleness of Mind, Keep The Commandments, Kindness, Longsuffering, Meekness, Repent and Forsake

<u>Telestial Kingdom – Like the Stars:</u>

As one star differ from another star in glory.

Telestial glory will be reserved for individuals who "received not the gospel of Christ, neither the testimony of Jesus".

These individuals will receive their glory after being redeemed from spirit prison, which is sometimes called hell.

Anger, Blasphemy, Concupiscence, Covetousness, Discord, Disobedience, Doing Contrary to the Laws of God, Envy, Evil, False Witness, Filthy Communication, Fornication, Gluttony, Graven Image, Greed, Hath, Honour Thy Father and Mother, Idolatry, Inordinate Affection, Keep the Sabbath Day, Laziness, Lust, Lying, Malice, Mischief, Neglecting, No Other Gods, Piety, Pride, Shalt Not Bear False Witness Against Thy Neighbour, Shalt Not Commit Adultery, Shalt Not Covet Thy Neighour's Property, Shalt Not Kill, Shalt Not Steal, Sloth, Take Lords Name In Vain, Triumphing over Others, Uncleanness, Wicked Imaginations, Wrath, and Etc.

Perdition:

Some people will not be worthy to dwell in any kingdom of glory.

They will be called "the sons of perdition" and will have to "abide a kingdom which is not a kingdom of glory".

This will be the state of "those who know [God's] power, and have been made partakers thereof, and suffered themselves through the power of the devil to be overcome, and to deny the truth and defy [God's] power".
